Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell

The Meeting will be held in the usual 'Quaker Room'. Windows will be open, so you may wish to bring an extra layer of clothing.

Friends can also join the Meeting via Zoom, with online Friends displayed on a laptop screen. The laptop camera, microphone and speakers will be on.

Formal restrictions for gathering inside buildings have been lifted, but it remains important to observe hygiene and respect other people's personal space. You may wish to wear a face mask when moving around the building, or during the meeting.

On arrival

Enter through the main door at the front of the building. Hand sanitiser is provided.

Go through the concourse to the glass doors, where the Quaker doorkeeper will greet you, but not shake your hand.

During the Meeting

The microphone is sensitive, but please ensure any spoken ministry is given loudly and clearly.

Coughs and sniffles – remember to "Catch it – Kill it - Bin it". Tissues, sanitiser and waste bags are available.

Closing the Meeting

Elders will close the meeting at approximately 11.15, with the words "Thank you Friends". Shaking hands is optional.

The Clerk will give any notices and Friends may share news. There will be no collection.

Friends are welcome to stay in the room and chat. Tea and coffee is available from the café area. Leave the building by the main doors.
