Friends will also be joining the Meeting via Zoom to create a 'blended' meeting. The Zoom call will be shown via projector on a screen. Please contact Clerks if you would like to join us online.

Face coverings must be worn inside the building (mask or visor), unless you are exempt for health or other reasons.

You may wish to bring:

- a drink (no refreshments will be provided)
- your own copy of Quaker Faith and Practice, Advices & Queries, Bible or other literature

Clerks will keep a record of those attending and contact details to support the NHS Track and Trace system.

On arrival

Enter through the main door at the front of the building, where you will be asked to sanitise your hands.

Go through the concourse to the glass doors, where the Quaker doorkeeper will greet you, and show you to a seat in the Meeting Room.

Please do not change seat, or touch/move the other chairs. Keep any coats and other personal possessions with you.

A camera and microphone will link Friends in the church with those who are joining via Zoom. These will be switched on for the duration of the meeting.

During the Meeting

The microphone is sensitive, but please ensure any spoken ministry is given loudly and clearly.

Coughs and sniffles – remember to “Catch it – Kill it - Bin it”. Tissues, sanitiser and waste bags will be available.

Closing the Meeting

Elders will close the meeting at approximately 11.15, with the words “Thank you Friends”; there will be no shared handshake.

Clerks will give any notices and Friends may share news.

There will be no collection.

After the meeting

Current Government guidelines do not allow ‘mingling’ after worship, so Friends will be asked to leave the building promptly.

Any social chat should take place outside.

The accessible toilet is just down the corridor; sanitiser should be used before and after touching the door handle
