1. Reading
QFP 22.14 and QFP 22.16 have been read

2. Area Meeting at Crewe and Nantwich, 13 July
Area Meeting will be held at Crewe and Nantwich on 13 July. Our representative will be Tim C

3. Wedding of David K and Peter C
David and Peter have now confirmed that their wedding will take place at the Meeting House on 2 November, starting at 3pm. The required paperwork has been completed and will be forwarded to Area Meeting. David and Peter will liaise with us nearer the time regarding catering

4. Stockport Pride
We agree to have a joint stall with Stockport for Peace at Stockport Pride on 28 July. This will cost £15 (with an extra £25 if we need a fire certificate for a gazebo). We hope that this will be shared between us and Stockport for Peace. Julia H will collect any suitable literature from Friends House for us to have on our stall. We recognise that we are there to support the LGBT agenda and not merely to promote our own. We authorise our Treasurer to pay any necessary expenses

5. Hospitality
Frances M raised this issue at our last Local Meeting in May and we agreed to revisit it when more Friends were present. We discussed this and several different viewpoints were aired. Pat C will source some biscuits with sustainable ingredients for those who want them and we will arrange a separate meeting at a future date to discuss the wider issues this has raised. 6. Ludlow Meeting House appeal
Ludlow Meeting House is a former farm building which was converted into a Meeting House in 1986. Ludlow Friends are appealing for funding to upgrade the building and to install modern toilets with wheelchair access. We agree to send £25 and ask our Treasurer to arrange this

7. Dundee Meeting House appeal
Dundee Meeting House was built in 1891 on a city centre site and has Grade II listed status. Dundee Friends have recently been able to return to using the building, which until recently had been let for commercial use. They are now appealing for funds to upgrade the building, not least so it can be used by a variety of groups. We agree to send £25 and ask our Treasurer to arrange this

8. Fund-raising lunch

A lunch held in April raised £117. This in aid of an appeal from Stockport Baptist Church who are seeking funding to pay the rent of three asylum seekers
